Why?

A small, green tattoo is placed close to the incision site when an animal is spayed/neutered. Tattoos let shelters and Veterinarians easily identify that an animal has already been spayed/neutered. This is especially important for female animals, as presence of a tattoo can help the animal avoid undergoing an unnecessary surgery in the future.
